**Pool players** Players (pool & fully registered) must be financial members of TNSW. To be eligible to play in semi & finals a person must have played a minimum of 3 matches with that team and be a fully registered member of the team. Pool players must upgrade registration to full registration before eligible to participate in semi and final series. Participation in wet matches will only be recognised if a card is submitted with the players name completed.

**Registration fees** \$15.00/person Pool player \$5.00/person (Pool players may play with any team in the competition twice before full registration required.)

**TNSW 2010-2011 Affiliation** \$21.00 Adult 19 & over , or \$14.00 Juniors 18 years & under.

**MATCH FEE/NIGHT = \$8.00 PER PERSON** includes court hire and 2 match balls with each team taking one ball home each night

**\*\*\* If you are short a player ring around the teams with extra players or, where applicable, the team with the bye before ringing Geoff for a replacement. Always turn up, as reserves may be available on site.**

## MONDAY NIGHT COMPETITION

2 Persons

**Matches shall consist of Six (6) tiebreak sets with the tiebreak game at 5 games all.**

**Each player shall participate in three (2) Doubles sets and (2) Singles Set.**

e.g. 2 sets Doubles 1 & 2 -v- 1 & 2

4 sets Singles Against each opponent

Seeding not applicable for 2 player team.

The seeding order played in the third match of the competition **may not be altered for the remainder of the competition** without approval of the Competition Secretary. When higher graded player/s do not take part in a match, borrowed or pool players must be played in their order of ability. At all times players will play in the order determined from the 3<sup>rd</sup> match. Where seeds are played out of order, or in the opinion of the Competition Committee following a protest, borrowed or pool players are incorrectly seeded, points WILL BE DEDUCTED and/or sets forfeit.9

### **Commencement time of match 7.30 PM**

**PAYMENT** for Court hire **MUST** be made before the match commences. Get into the habit of having the captain pay team fees on arrival at court before match commences.

**Finishing time** is no later than 11.00 PM. Always record the score of the set in progress should the lights go out before completion of the match. The Association will allocate one (1) point for each set won and four (4) points for winning on games - if games are even, bonus points go to team with most sets, if games & sets are even, the points are shared. Points will be shared for unplayed or unfinished sets.

**Home Team** shall be the first mentioned in the draw.

**The server** in the first set shall be decided on a toss and the service shall alternate in subsequent sets.

**Set put on.** The Visiting Team shall put on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> sets. The Home Team shall put on the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> sets.

**Claiming Forfeits:** Teams who do not have a pair ready to play at the stipulated time must forfeit a set. On expiration of ten (10) minutes the second set can be claimed, and at intervals of ten (10) minutes subsequent sets can be claimed until the end of the fifth set, when the match can be claimed. (Many of the participants in this competition have work commitments that cause them to be late on occasions, it is preferable to play around a late player rather than claim forfeits, after all everyone is here to play.)

Result Cards – **Please make sure full Given and Surnames are written** on the card and record singles result next to full name. Card must be completed and signed by both captains. It is the responsibility of the winning Team to forward the card to the Competition Secretary within 48 hours of the match being played. Cards must be left in the result card box.
